The 2011 Island Arts Camp offers students in grades K-8 a chance to spend five days in one and two hour blocks creating art, performance, dance, and music with professional artists. Every child participates in a variety of activities at the Island Arts Camp, giving participants a unique week's experience across many artistic disciplines.

This summer camp is designed for fun and creativity while also structured to build on educational core values.

Each day includes recitals, presentations, and time for outdoor exercise during the lunch hour. Please provide your child with a healthy snack and a brown bag lunch. The campers are divided into 6 groups of 15 students each, roughly on the basis of age and grade level. The day is broken into four blocks with snack and lunch breaks; and, for the camp's youngest two groups, concludes with a one-hour story, singing, and rest time, with guests from the community.

The Language of Gesture with Ian Bannon

Students at DI/S schools have worked with shadow puppets with Figures of Speech teaching artist Ian Bannon, but here they will learn to animate large Japanese-style bunraku puppets; to communicate thoughts, feelings, and ideas through gesture alone; and to work with "constructive critique" in devising projects to produce.

Ian is the the director of the highly successful FOSSE (Figures of Speech Student Ensemble), which challenges students to devise original productions of classic tales from around the world.
